

#### ON THIS DATE IN...

JULY

**July 1, 1850** – Naval School at Annapolis renamed Naval Academy.

**July 3, 2002** – The first of the Coast Guard's Maritime Safety and Security Teams was commissioned in Seattle, WA.

#### July 4 – HAPPY 244th BIRTHDAY

#### **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA!!!**

**July 6, 1911** – The first naval aviation base is established at Annapolis, MD.

**July 6, 1976** – Women enter the Naval Academy.

**July 9, 1943** – Coast Guard-manned ships land the first Allied troops in Sicily.

**July 11, 1941** – Congress reconfirmed the military "status" of the Coast Guard.

July 12, 1862 – The Medal of Honor is created.

**July 12, 1957** – President Dwight D. Eisenhower takes the first presidential ride in a helicopter.

**July 12, 1990** – Commander Rosemary B. Mariner becomes the first woman to command an operational aviation squadron.

**July 14, 1813** – Lt. John M. Gamble, the first marine to command a ship in battle.

**July 14, 1952** – Laying of keel of USS *Forrestal*, the first 59,900-ton aircraft carrier.

**July 17, 1994 -** USCGC *Polar Sea* (WAGB-11), became the first U.S. surface vessel to reach the North Pole.

**July 20, 1960** – In the first launch of Polaris missiles, USS *George Washington* (SSBN 598) successfully first 2 operational Polaris missiles while submerged of Florida.

**July 20, 1969** – Former Navy pilot Neil Armstrong is the first man to set foot on the moon. While taking the first step, he said, "That's one small step for man, one giant leap for mankind."

**July 23, 1993** – Sarah Deal becomes the first woman selected for naval aviation training.

**July 25, 1947** – The Women's Reserve of the Coast Guard Reserve (SPARS) was disestablished.

**July 26, 1947** – The National Security Act of 1947 became effective, reaffirming the status of the Marine Corps as a separate military service within the Department of the Navy.

**July 26, 1948** – President Harry S. Truman orders desegregation of the Armed Services.

**July 27, 1953** – Korean War armistice signed at Panmunjon, Korea and the Korean cease-fire went into effect at 10:00 pm.

**July 28, 1918** – BGen John A. Lejeune USMC, assumed command of the 2nd Division, U.S. Army in France, and remained in that capacity until August 1919 when the unit was demobilized.

**July 29, 1846** – Sailors and Marines from U.S. sloop *Cyane* capture San Diego, CA.
