On February 23, 1922, "Acting" Secretary of the Navy Teddy Roosevelt Jr., issued General Order 78, establishing Destroyer Base San Diego. Since then, the base has had other names to include; Repair Base San Diego during WWII and Naval Station San Diego from post WWII until the late 1990's. Today it's name is Naval Base San Diego and the second largest naval installation in the United States and the premier base



on the west coast, homeport to Naval Surface Forces Pacific Fleet with 57 Navy ships and over 150 tenant commands. The base encompasses 1,600 land and 326 water acres with a combined population of over 35,000 Sailors, civilians and contractors.
