

NAVY HERITAGE

Destroyer Squadron ONE (DESRON1) is a squadron of warships in the United States Navy. DESRON1 was initially listed in the U.S. Navy's order of battle in the Navy Directories of 1919, but disappeared from the Naval Register in 1927. In 1937, Destroyer Squadron Twenty was re-designated as DESRON1 and was present during the Attack on Pearl Harbor, 7 December 1941. Its destroyers served as part of Task Force 11 in the aborted relief efforts for Wake Island and many other significant campaigns; Battle of Coral Sea, Battle of Midway, Battle of the Eastern



Solomons as part of Task Force 16 and the initial phase of the Guadalcanal campaign, to include many others. In September 1943, the squadron returned to the West Coast for overhaul. DESRON1 has subsequently participated in the Korean War and the Taiwan Strait Patrols. The Destroyer Squadron was re-designated as Reserve Destroyer Squadron 27, established on January 13, 1958, which was subsequently re-designated Destroyer Squadron 27 in 1970 and Surface Squadron 1 in 1980 before being returned to its original designation of Destroyer Squadron One in October 1993. DESRON1 has participated in the Gulf Wars; Operations Iraqi Freedom, Enduring Freedom and New Dawn. Today, it serves an operational component of Carrier Strike Group One and is administratively responsible to Commander, Naval Surface Forces Pacific. Its Destroyers operates in the Third Fleet Area of Responsibility and deploys to the Middle East as part of the U.S. Fifth Fleet, Western Pacific as part of the U.S. Seventh Fleet, and regularly support Joint Task Force North counter-drug operations in South America and the Caribbean Sea, as well as other fleet commitments. The Squadron Headquarters is located at Naval Base San Diego and its current composition of warships in the squadron includes: USS O'KANE (DDG-77), USS McCAMPBELL (DDG-85), USS MUSTIN (DDG-89), USS KIDD (DDG-100), USS STERETT (DDG-104), USS STOCKDALE (DDG-106) and USS WILLIAM P. LAWRENCE (DDG 110).
