

NAVY HERITAGE

David Glasgow Farragut was a flag officer of the United States Navy during the American Civil War. He was the first Rear Admiral, Vice Admiral and Admiral in the United States Navy. He is remembered for his order at the Battle of Mobile Bay which was the turning point of the civil war; "Damn the Torpedoes, Full Speed Ahead". His legacy namesake lives on in many cities, schools, libraries, roads, highways, and State parks and National landmarks. Including, at many Naval installations ashore and historically at sea with two former separate U.S. Navy Destroyer lead classes; Farragut class of 1934 and class of 1958. There have been five Navy ships to bear his namesake, with the most recent today, an Arleigh Burke-class destroyer; USS FARRAGUT (DDG 99) and a Ticonderoga Class Cruiser with the namesake of the famous Battle of Mobile Bay Admiral Farragut lead; USS MOBILE BAY (CG 53). Today the phrase of "Full Speed Ahead" is still used.
