# NAVY HERITAGE

On Sept 14, 1970, Chief of Naval Operations (CNO) Admiral Elmo.R. Zumwalt, Jr. established the Navy Family Ombudsman Program to improve communication between commands and the families of Sailors who served in them. In 2006, CNO Admiral Michael G. Mullen, re-emphasized the importance of the program and implemented all Navy families have access to a Navy Family Ombudsman. The Ombudsman is a volunteer, appointed by the commanding officer, to serve as an information link between command leadership and Navy families. Ombudsmen are trained to disseminate information both up and down the chain of command on official command information, command climate issues, local quality of life improvement opportunities and "good deals" around the



community. Ombudsman also provide resource referrals when needed. They are instrumental in resolving family issues before the issues require extensive command attention. For 53 years, civilian volunteers appointed by local commanding officers have willingly dedicated themselves to our Sailors and their families' welfare across the globe. To celebrate the inception of the program, each September is recognized as Ombudsman Appreciation Month.

Qualified as Officer of the Deck underway on four ships, Tactical Action Officer on two platforms; she earned distinction as Carrier Strike Group Nine Ship-Handler of the Year in 2006 and was honored by peer-nominated award for Leadership Excellence in 2015. Her tours afloat include USNS ANDREW J. HIGGINS (TAO 190), USS MCKEE (AS 41), USNS POINT LOMA (TAGOS 2), PCU USS DONALD COOK (DDG 75), USS GONZALEZ (DDG 66), USS ROSS (DDG 71), USS ABRAHAM LINCOLN (CVN 72), USS VELLA GULF (CG 72), USS HARRY S. She served as the Commanding Officer of Mobile Mine Assembly Group and as Force Combat Systems Officer (N435) Commander Naval Air Forces Pacific in San Diego, CA and as Lead Strike Force Interoperability Officer Pacific,

Naval Information Forces in San Diego, CA. She is currently serving as Technical Director Information Warfare Readiness Directorate and Overmatch Lead Naval Information Forces in San Diego, CA.

Awarded the Meritorious Service Medal (4 awards), Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal (8 awards), Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (6 awards), and various tour and campaign awards.
