# NAVY HERITAGE

On Sunday morning December 7, 1941, the Imperial Japanese Navy attacked U.S. Navy Base in Pearl Harbor killing 2,403 Americans. The raid by aircraft carrierborne warplanes sunk or damaged 21 U.S. warships – including the USS Arizona and USS Oklahoma, destroyed or damaged 347 aircraft. Japan, and Nazi Germany had conquered much of Asia, Europe and North Africa by the end of 1941. The shape of the future world began to turn in the midst of the attack on Pearl Harbor, where America overcame the shock of sudden attack and began to fight back. Fifteen



Sailors and one Marine earned the Medal of Honor for heroic actions that day alone. Among them were Rear Admiral Isaac Kidd, who died commanding the defense from the bridge of USS Arizona, the first U.S. flag officer killed in any war; Captain Mervyn Bennion, who remained in command of USS West Virginia, saving the ship despite mortal wounds; and Chief Boatswain Edwin Hill, whose remarkable heroics freed the USS Nevada while under attack. USS Nevada was the only battleship to set sail that morning. She went on to distinguished service in the war and helped lead the D-Day invasion of Europe in 1944 and the final attacks on the Japanese home islands in the summer of 1945. USS West Virginia also survived the Pearl Harbor attack, but at the loss of 106 Sailors, and was able to triumphantly sail into Tokyo Bay to witness the surrender of Japan and the end of World War II aboard USS Missouri as Japan formally signed documents of surrender on September 2, 1945, with the ceremony lasting only 23 minutes. Yet it ended more than a total decade of devastating global conflict that killed 60 million people or more in Asia, Europe and Africa, and in other battles fought on land, air and sea around the world. "Today, the guns are silent. A great tragedy has ended. A great victory has been won," U.S. Gen. Douglas MacArthur said in an international radio address while officiating during the ceremonies aboard USS Missouri. Today, USS Missouri still serves the country in Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, where she is the certerpiece of the Battleship Missouri Memorial.



# BREAKFAST SPEAKER

#### Captain Omar G. Martinez, currently serving as the Director of Operations and Training, Naval Service Training Command, was born and raised in Cedar Rapids, Iowa. He enlisted in the U.S. Navy in August 1986 and completed Recruit Training in Orlando, Florida. In March 2000, the Navy commissioned him as an Ensign in Limited Duty Officer program.

Captain Martinez's operational and sea duty assignments include: USS CARL VINSON (CVN 70) from September 2013 to October 2015 where he served as Executive Department Head and Admin Officer and completed an extended 10 month deployment in support of Operation INHERENT RESOLVE; Admin Officer tour onboard USS BONHOMME RICHARD (LHD 6) from March 2009 through May 2011, completing a U.S. FIFTH Fleet deployment supporting Maritime Security Operations and the 2010 Rim of the Pacific exercise; Personnel Officer, Admin Officer and Executive Department Head onboard USS CONSTELLATION (CV 64) from August 2002 through October 2003, where the CONSTELLATION Strike Group supported initial combat operations during Operation IRAQI FREEDOM; and N1 Assistant Chief of Staff for Administration, Manpower and Personnel for Special Boat Squadron ONE, Coronado, California. His enlisted operational assignments include U.S. THIRD Fleet embarked on USS CORONADO, (AGF 11); his Leading Petty Officer at sea tour onboard USS CONSTELLATION (CV 64) from November 1993 through December 1995 completing a U.S. FIFTH Fleet

deployment in support of Operation SOUTHERN WATCH; and as a Plank Owner of the USS THOMAS S. GATES (CG 51) on which he served with her commissioning crew from January 1987 to August 1990. During this time, he deployed and completed GATES' maiden deployment while participating in a historic port visit to the Soviet Union.

Captain Martinez reported as the Director, Commander's Action Group in September of 2022 and moved to the Director of Operations and Training in April 2023. Previous shore assignments include: Chief of Staff, Chief of Naval Personnel/Commanding Officer of Troops (COT), Executive Officer, Naval Station Great Lakes; Assistant Chief of Staff (N1) at U.S. THIRD Fleet; Flag Secretary for Commander Naval Forces, U.S. Pacific Fleet; Fleet Logistics Squadron FOUR ZERO; and Navy Recruiting District, Milwaukee.

Captain Martinez is Surface Warfare Officer qualified and his personal awards include the Legion of Merit, Meritorious Service Medal (five awards), Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal (seven awards), Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (three awards) and numerous campaign and unit wards. He is the recipient of the prestigious Commander Naval Air Force, U.S. Pacific Fleet Navy and Marine Association Leadership award.
