NAVY HERITAGE

Marine Air Support Squadron (MASS) 3 is a United States Marine Corps aviation command and control unit. MASS3 was originally commissioned as Marine Tactical Air Control Squadron 3 on 3 August 1950 under Marine Air Control Group 2 and 1st Marine Aircraft Wing. MASS3 provides capabilities for control and coordination of aircraft operating in direct support of Marine Air-Ground Task



Force Operations and process immediate air support requests, integrate aircraft with supporting arms, manage terminal control assets and procedurally control aircraft. MASS3 is based out of the 32 area on Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California and fall under the command of Marine Air Control Group 38 and the 3rd Marine Aircraft Wing.

Lieutenant Colonel Tyrone G. Anub Jr., is a graduate of California State University, Sacramento, with a Bachelor of Arts in Philosophy and was commissioned a Second Lieutenant in 2007. Following graduation from The Basic School and Air Support Control Officer Course in 29 Palms, Second Lieutenant Anub reported to Marine Air Support Squadron 1, Marine Air Control Group 28 aboard Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, NC where he was assigned as a 2nd platoon commander with Air Support Company.

Second Lieutenant Anub deployed with MASS-1 in 2009 in support of Operation Enduring Freedom serving as Helicopter Director and Tactical Air Director during Operation Khanjar. Upon his return he resumed duties as a platoon command, later being assigned as the executive officer of Air Support Company, Commanding Officer of Air Support Company, and Commanding Officer of Headquarters and Services Company. In 2010 First Lieutenant Anub graduated with honors from the Martial Arts Instructor course aboard the School of Infantry, East.



In July of 2011 First Lieutenant Anub was assigned as the Air Support Element Officer in charge and detached to the MACG-28 detachment, Marine Medium Tilt-rotor squadron 261 (reinforced), 24th Marine Expeditionary Unit and deployed as such in January of 2012. He completed the Weapons and Tactics Instructor Course 2-13 earning the 7277 MOS. Captain Anub reported to Marine Aviation Weapons and Tactics Squadron 1 in June, 2013 to serve as Direct Air Support Center Division Head. During this time Captain Anub completed Expeditionary Warfare School and the Tactical Tomahawk Commander's Course. In summer of 2016, Captain Anub reported to Marine Operational Test and Evaluation Squadron 1 (VMX-1) to serve as the DASC Division head and Operational Test Director for the Tactical Air Control Element (TACE).

In the winter of 2016 he was selected to Major and to attend resident Professional Military Education at the US Naval War College in Newport, Rl. During this time, Major Anub earned a Master of Arts, with Distinction, in Defense and Strategic Studies. Following graduation from the War College, in 2018, Major Anub returned to Yuma for duty as the Operations Officer and Executive Officer MACS-1. Major Anub reported to HQMC Aviation in July of 2020 and was subsequently assigned to Joint Task Force – National Capitol Region to serve as the Operations officer for Joint Team Capitol for the 2021 Inauguration. In March of 2021 he returned to the Pentagon to assume his responsibilities as AXE-5.

Lieutenant Colonel Anub reported to Marine Air Control Group 18, Okinawa Japan in July of 2023 to serve as Operations Officer and earning designation as a Sector Air Defense Commander. He was selected for Command of MASS-3 in September of 2023. Lieutenant Colonel Anub's personal decorations include the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service medal (with gold star), Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal (with two gold stars), and the Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal.

Breakfast Sponsor in the Spotlight

Navy Federal was originally incorporated on 17 January 1933 as the Navy Department Employees' Credit Union of the District of Columbia. Only Navy Department employees who were members of the federal employees' labor union and members of their families were eligible to join. The next year, President Roosevelt signed into law the Federal Credit Union Act., which would eventually become the basis of business for the credit union. On July 17, 1947, the credit union was granted a federal charter as a credit union, named Navy Department Employees Federal Credit Union. It also expanded membership to include



all Navy personnel in the Washington, D.C., area, both military and civilian. In May 2008, Navy Federal Credit Union (NFCU) widened its membership to include the entire Department of Defense (DoD), which made eligible all active duty, retired, and reserve Army, Navy, Marine Corps and Air Force personnel, as well as contractor and civilian personnel within the DoD. In March 2013, NFCU further widened its membership to include all Coast Guard members and employees and Space Force members in 2020. Since 1933, NFCU has grown from 7 members to over 13.5 million members and \$171B in assets as of January 2024, holding distinction as the world's largest credit union since April 1962. NFCU is an American global credit union headquartered in Vienna, Virginia, charted and regulated under the authority of the National Credit Union Administration, where NFCU puts its members financial needs first with low fees, great rates and discounts at any of the 355 branches, many located near military bases. NFCU is proud to be a member-owned, not for profit credit union supporting all branches of the military, DoD, veterans, and their families through every stage of life. The San Diego Council is honored to have NFCU as a community partner.
