NAVY HERITAGE

Marine Air Control Squadron (MACS-1) is a United States Marine Corps aviation command and control squadron. MACS1 was originally established as; Air Warning Squadron 1 and commissioned on 1 September 1943 at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, North Carolina and served as the first early warning squadron organized under the newly established 1st Marine Air Warning Group, 3rd Marine Aircraft Wing. Today, the squadron provides aerial surveillance, air traffic control, ground-controlled intercept, and aviation data-link connectivity for the 1 Marine Expeditionary Force. It was the first air warning squadron commissioned as part of the Marine Corps' new air warning program and is the second oldest aviation command and control unit in the Marine Corps. The squadron is based at Marine Corps Air Station Yuma and falls under Marine Air Control Group 38 and 3rd Marine Air Wing.
